CONSIDERATION OF THE DRAFT CONVENTION ON THE RECOGNITION AND
ENFORCEMENT OF FOREIGN ARBITRAL AWARDS (ITEM 4 OF THE AGENDA)

United Kingdom: amendment to article II of the draft Convention

Article II should be amended to read as follows:

"In the territories of any State to which the present Convention applies or is extended, an arbitral award shall be recognized as binding and shall be enforced in accordance with rules of procedure not more complicated than those used for the enforcement of any other award of the territory where the award is relied upon, under the conditions laid down in the following articles, and in no case shall the scale of fees and charges demandable be excessive nor greater than those demandable in respect of the enforcement of any other award."
