Israel: proposed amendment to the United Kingdom amendment to Article II
of the draft Convention

In the territories of any State to which the present Convention applies (or is extended), an arbitral award shall, under the conditions laid down in the following articles, be recognized as binding and be enforced in accordance with rules of procedure substantially similar to those applying to the enforcement of domestic arbitral awards and any fees or charges in connexion therewith shall not be (excessive nor) greater than those demandable in respect of the enforcement of any other award.
