## United Kingdom: proposed emendment to Article IV

- 1. Delete Article IV (e).
- 2. Add at the end of Article IV: "An award shall be deemed recognizable and enforceable for the purpose of Article III if at the expiration of sixty days after it has been given or, in the case of an appeal, after it has been duly notified, no further steps have been taken to upset or to appeal against the award."
